An example of objects would be:

- Meat
- Poultry
- Cheese
- Sugar
- Food Additives
- Processed & Prepared Food
- Animal Products
- Pharmaceuticals Products
- Healthcare Products

An example of <u>actions</u> would be:

- Slaughter practices
- Manufacturing Techniques
- Retailing
- Catering
- Logistics
- Shipping
- Storage
- •Islamic banking
- Finance

It is extremely difficult to live in a world free from these objects or actions as they are part of our daily life.

For this reasons and others, the Halal Services should go as far as it should.

Halal Services should not be limited to only meat.

Halal Services should have no limits, no barrier and no boundaries.

We in the 4th world Halal forum have been chosen among many Muslims to carry the task of Halal.

The existing Halal Services must be upgraded to internationally recognized standards, like the ISO series.

Halal certifiers should collaborate with <u>accredited bodies</u> that will play the role of accreditations.

Accredited Bodies will also keep an eye on Halal certifications through their accredited bodies.

Because the News of Halal not only it must be broadcasted from an accredited Muslim body, for its qualifications in implementing Halal standards;

It must also be <u>accredited for its</u> being a trust worthy <u>Muslim and</u> a trust worthy <u>source of information</u>, to allow for the flow of Halal news through its proper religious points.

For this reason

An internationally recognized Muslim organization such as The Muslim World League that has the lead in verifying Muslim individuals and organizations for decades.

Or

Ministries of Islamic Affairs in the importing countries must be involved as the source of proper religious points.
