 - Promoting the development of Halal standards and its applications.



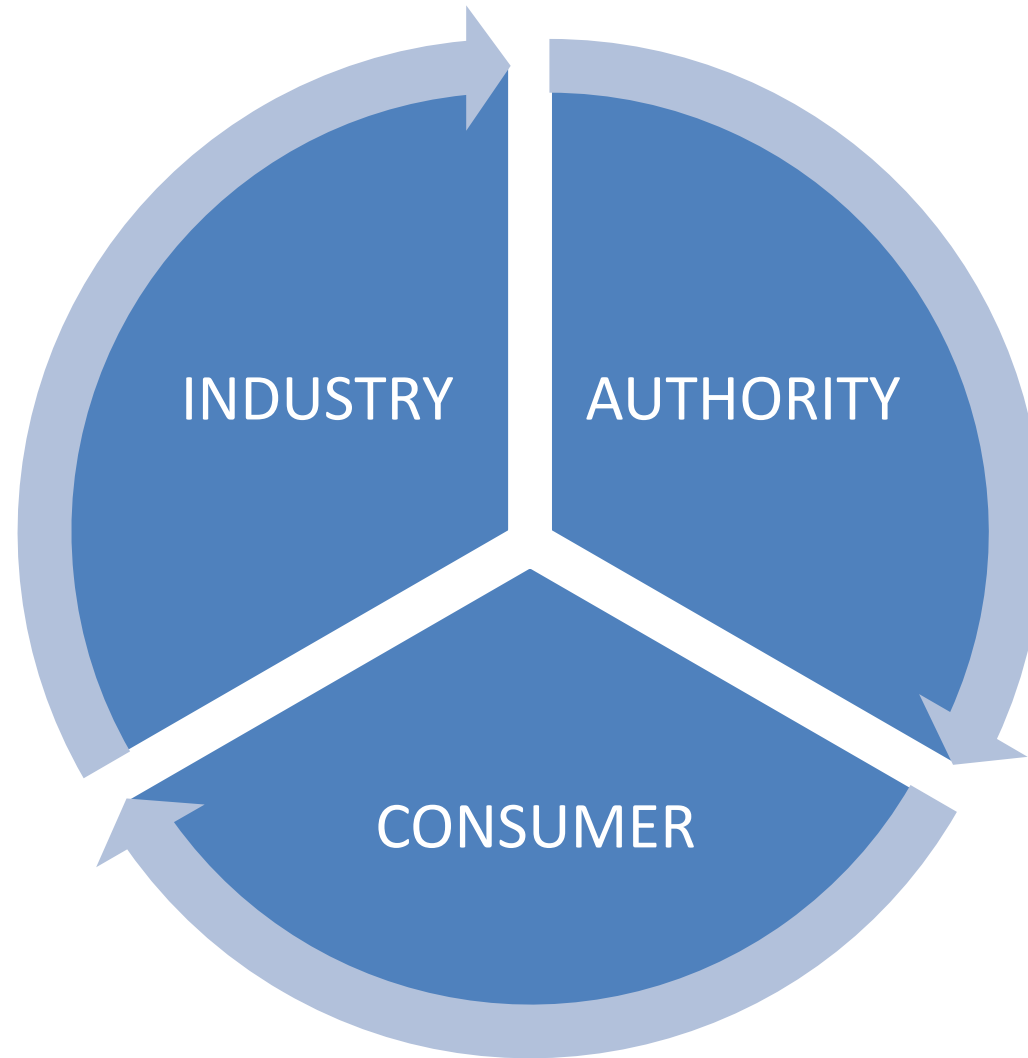
